Orientation Quick Reference Guide 2025–2026 School Year

Mission

A Christ-centered homeschool community encouraging, equipping, and supporting families as they disciple young men and women of character to influence the world for Jesus Christ.

Check-In & Attendance

- Check in/out at lobby tablets every time you enter/exit.
- Teachers also take attendance in each class.

Parent Responsibilities

- Co-op is not a drop-off program. Parents are always responsible for their children.
- Supervise during lunch, recess, and free periods.
- Children under 10 must remain with an adult at lunch.

Health & Safety

- Stay home if your child has had fever in the last 24 hrs or has vomiting/diarrhea/croupy cough.
- No weapons, fire-starters, or unsafe items.
- Playground and gym use only with supervision.
- Emergency: Follow fire/tornado drill procedures; parents remain with children.

Code of Conduct

- Show respect, kindness, and honesty.
- Dress modestly.
- No fighting, profanity, or bullying.
- Teens: Do not isolate with opposite gender peers or wander in pairs.

Bullying Policy

- Zero tolerance for bullying, racism, or harassment.
- Three-strike discipline:
 1. Verbal warning
 2. Meeting with parent
 3. Removal from class/event
- Severe cases may result in immediate dismissal.

Facility Guidelines

- Food/drinks stay in dining hall (water bottles w/lids OK in classrooms).
- Classrooms off limits during lunch.

- Sanctuary & kitchen are restricted areas.
- Keep belongings organized; lost & found at security desk.

Service Hours

- Families serve together to make co-op possible.
- 1 hour at co-op = 7 service hours per semester.
- Extra volunteer opportunities posted weekly.
- Community Service Hours outside co-op (events, clean-up, repairs, supply donations) count toward early registration.

Weather & Closings

- Co-op closes if Licking County is under a Level 2 Snow Emergency.
- Notices via text, email, Facebook, and website.

Communication

- Join our private Facebook group and check the website forums for updates.
- Speak with teachers before/after class or during free periods (not during class).
